- 1.** Page 4, Section 5, after Bullet Point 1, new Bullet Point 2:

This to include specific support for the National Officer responsible for the reference of Health and Safety and introduction of new dimension equipment and working practices. This support is to be provided by seconded members of The Fire Brigades Union who have the necessary level of training and experience to support fully the National Officer. This support to be provided until the work load diminishes to a level that the Executive Council in consultation with the National Officer and the National Health and Safety Sub Committee believes that the additional assistance is no longer required.

Re-number the remaining bullet point points 3 and 4.

- 2. Page 2, Section 1**

After last bullet point insert new paragraph

If the implementation of the regionalisation of Emergency Fire Controls results in the Conditions of Service and employment for Emergency Fire Control staff being changed to “non uniform” status, prior to any decision on “non uniformed” membership of the FBU, then the Executive Council will immediately implement the necessary rule changes to ensure that Emergency Fire Control staff can remain members of the FBU.
